Your Favorite Nonprofit requests a grant of \$8500 to be used specifically in our walk-up food pantry. In our community, 20% of single-mother-led households experience food insecurity. We seek to provide free of charge pantry staples, personal hygiene items, and fresh produce to women and children enrolled in our other programs. Access to the food pantry is available when families are on-site for our other programs. This has the added benefit of helping ensure that children are not hungry during school breaks. We will use granted funds to purchase popular items in bulk. We measure success of the food pantry program by monthly check-ins with its users, who complete an in-person multifaceted survey of many life development areas.
